The Revised Roman Missal: Praying in a Revised Way: The language of the mass is changing. On the 1st Sunday of Advent, November 27, the revised Roman Missal will be implemented at Sunday Eucharist throughout English parishes in Canada. The *Constitution of the Sacred Liturgy*, a document of Vatican II, calls all the faithful to 'full, conscious, and active participation in the Eucharist.'
