Your Excellency,

The Orthodox Christian Sisterhood in honor of St Martyr Grand Princess Elisabeth was founded in Minsk in 1996. The St Elisabeth Convent was founded in summer of 1999. The nuns and the sisters of mercy take care of the inmates and patients of a boarding home for mentally challenged children, the boarding home #3 for mentally and physically challenged adults, the National Psychiatric Clinical Hospital, Research Institute for Pulmonology and Phtisiology, and the city clinical hospital #2.

These patients need constant support owing to the fact that their illnesses make it impossible for them to adapt socially. These people have an opportunity to work in the convent's workshops, among which there are sewing and embroidery workshop, gold embroidery workshop, icon painting studio and icon board workshop, candle works studio, ceramics workshop, stone workshop, joiner's workshop, audio and video studio and a publishing house. Those who have nowhere to live are provided with accommodation and we hope that we will have an opportunity to build premises for such people not far from the convent.

The workshops have grown and developed in the recent years of our ministry, therefore we desperately need new premises. It was God's mercy that we obtained a spacious unfinished house near the Minsk ring road. However, we still have a lot to do to move some of the workshops into this House of Love of Labor, as we call it.

Therefore, would you be so kind to grant us your permission to contact the parishes and monastic communities of the Archdiocese of Perth and inquire them about a possibility to arrange a small table with our goods after the mass, to introduce the convent and its activities to the parishioners, hoping that people will help us and respond to the needs of those whom we take care of.

Thank you very much for your help.
