

## CHANGES IN PRIESTS' CHARGES

Archbishop André Richard, c.s.c., has announced the following changes in the charges of diocesan priests.

- Rev. Mario Doyle, C.Ss.R. becomes moderator of the Marie Étoile de la mer Pastoral Unit which includes the parishes of Baie Sainte-Anne, Pointe-Sapin, St. Ignace and St. Louis. Rev. Doyle is presently in the Diocese of Bathurst. They will be joined by two colleagues, Rev. Alfred Desautels and Michel Mercier, presently part of the Elsipogtog and Our Lady of Hope Pastoral Units.
- Rev. Gilbert Lévesque, C.Ss.R., is named assistant moderator in the same pastoral unit.
- Rev. Jean-Bernard Mallais becomes moderator of the Sainte-Trinité Pastoral Unit which includes the parishes of Richibucto, Richibouctou-Village and St. Charles. Rev. Mallais is presently moderator of the Marie Étoile de la Mer Pastoral Unit.
- Rev. Robert Savoie becomes moderator of the Elsipogtog Pastoral Unit which includes the parishes of Bass River, Elsipogtog and Indian Island as well as the Our Lady of Hope Pastoral Unit which comprises Rexton and South Branch.
- Rev. Jean Bourque becomes moderator of the Bon Pasteur Pastoral Unit, replacing Rev. Ulysse LeBlanc, c.s.c.

A British priest, Rev. Laurence Quin-Morris, from the diocese of Arundel & Brighton, is coming to spend a sabbatical leave in our archdiocese. He will be available for ministry.

These nominations will take effect on August 1st, 2011.
