

Feed My Lambs, Session 5

The May session for *Feed my Lambs* took place on the 31st at St. Bernard's Church with Fr. Allison Carroll, priest moderator of St. Bernard's, St. Vincent's, St. Clement's and St. Bartholomew's. Fr. Allison is a Moncton native, who has served in many parishes in the diocese during his 33 years as a priest. The presence of so many people at his presentation visibly moved him as he began his presentation. His story was told with humour, honesty and poignancy ... often as he shared his stories, he would add: "This is true, this is a true story." While the priesthood has offered him many challenges, he has great faith that he is always where the Lord wants him to be. He affirmed the people he has ministered to over the years when he told those gathered that he has loved the time spent in each parish he has served.
