

Meet the Prophets

As Rev. Hugh Farquhar shares the message of the prophets with us, and explores the relevance for us today, the first thing one is struck by is that the more things change the more they stay the same. At a time of affluence and materialism for some and abject poverty for others,



Amos and Hosea, the two prophets whom Hugh has to date presented on, preached to Israel, calling them back to God. Though contemporaries, who may have known each other, neither speaks of the other; Amos offers Israel only a little glimpse of hope in his message of impending doom; Hosea is filled with hope and the constancy of God's love for God's people.
