

## Moncton leads other Dioceses in the Atlantic Provinces

The financial campaign aimed at helping the victims of the deadly earthquake in Haiti was a major success in the Archdiocese of Moncton. The sum of \$ 294,209 that was raised during last Spring's campaign places the Diocese at the top of the twelve dioceses in the Atlantic Provinces. On the national level, the Diocese of Moncton come in at the 17th position out of 66 dioceses.
